

# Dracaena Deremensis

## *Dracaena Lemon-Lime Plant*

The Dracaena Lemon Lime Plant has 12"-24" long sword shaped leaves with bright green and yellow stripes. Like other Dracaena plants, the leaves of a Dracaena Lemon Lime are arranged in a rosette and grow off a very thick stem. A Dracaena Lemon Lime is very easy to care for and can easily reach a height of 5-7ft. indoors. It also makes a beautiful bush. Because of the bright colors in the leaves, a Dracaena Lemon Lime needs a little more light than other Dracaenas. It's a great plant to brighten up any room in your house.

**Light:** This plant can adapt to low light, it does better in medium to indirect bright light. Too much direct bright light causes the color in the leaves to fade. Too little light and the new leaves are narrower than the older leaves.

**Water:** Allow the top 50% of the soil of the plant to dry out before watering. If the soil is too wet or too dry the leaves will develop brown tips. Always use non-fluoridated water for any type of Dracaena Plant. Dracaenas are very sensitive to chemicals in the water.



**Fertilizing:** Dracaena Plants require very little fertilizer. Feed with a good indoor plant food monthly in spring and summer at ½ the recommended strength. It's not necessary to feed Dracaenas in the fall or winter.
